

# BUSINESS SCHOOL STUDENT MOBILITY GRANT - APPLICATION PROCESS

In order to assist you in covering the cost of your overseas study experience the UniSA Business School offers [two types of grants](#):

1. UniSA Business School Student Mobility Grant
2. UniSA Business School Overseas Experience Grant

The above-mentioned grants are separate to other grant opportunities offered by UniSA International including [UniSA International Travel Grant](#). Other funding opportunities exist in the form of OS HELP Loans and Australian Government Scholarships, please visit the [Travel Grants](#) webpage for further information.

Please note that UniSA Business School grants are competitive and are not always guaranteed additional funding for Business School Students.

## GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

- Receive approval from your Program Director to undertake your exchange
- Apply for your overseas study experience – fall under three categories:
  - [Apply for your full semester exchange](#) via the Student Exchange team – an application for the UniSA International Travel Grant occurs concurrently
  - [Apply for your UniSA exchange partner short term exchange](#) experience via the Student Exchange team – an application for the UniSA International Travel Grant occurs concurrently
  - [Apply for other short-term opportunities](#) through third-party providers and register for the UniSA travel grant
- Complete and submit the Business School Grant Application Form
- Await assessment of your Business School Grant application and outcome of your exchange application
- Should you be awarded a Business School Grant you will need to provide your bank account details and evidence of your successful admission to your exchange program
- Receipt of your grant to your nominated bank account

## ELIGIBILITY

The grant application process is open to both undergraduate and postgraduate by coursework students who meet the criteria for undertaking exchange:

Undergraduate students:

- GPA of 4.0 or above
- No more than 9.0 failed units (2 courses)
- Full semester exchange applications should have successfully completed 36 units of their current program
- Short term exchange applications should have successfully completed 18 units of their current program

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Postgraduate students:

- GPA of 4.0 or above
- No more than 9.0 failed units (2 courses)
- Will need to have successfully completed 9 units of their current program or successfully completed an undergraduate degree at UniSA

## KEY DATES

Applications for UniSA Business School Grants close:

- 30 August for travel in SP1, SP2 or SP3
- 30 January for travel in SP4, SP5, SP6, SP7

Please note, applications take between four to six weeks to receive approval after the application closing date

## ABOUT THE GRANTS

### UniSA Business School Student Mobility Grant

You will be considered for this grant if you have:

- Applied for a full semester or short-term exchange with a [UniSA exchange partner university](#)

Please note that for short term exchange - tuition fees are subject to the UniSA partner institution, you may need to pay them upfront to the partner or to UniSA. This does not include any additional program fees such as: accommodation, cultural packages, student union fees etc.

### UniSA Business School Overseas Experience Grant

You will be considered for this grant if you have:

- Applied for a short-term experience such as a Study Tour or internship with a third-party provider (eg. with AIM Overseas, CIS Australia), or overseas conference, short term study with a University that is not an exchange partner of UniSA
