FITNESS TO PRACTICE INHERENT REQUIREMENTS



The Fitness to Practice Inherent Requirements provide a framework for understanding what will be needed to engage in Initial Teacher Education (ITE) Programs, with a focus on Professional Experience Placements and other practice-based learning experiences. It is important to understand that there is an expectation for development; preservice teachers are not expected to begin the program demonstrating practice at the level of a fully qualified professional but will be expected to demonstrate their strongest capacity from the beginning of their program and demonstrate developing skills across their progress through the program. To continue through the program and engage with ongoing Professional Experience placements, all required legal documentation must be kept up to date for the duration of the program.

While not all Inherent Requirements are specifically assessed, there will be opportunities to develop in these areas through assessment and/or reflection opportunities throughout the Education programs. Some examples of where your opportunities for development will be offered can be found in the relevant program tables below, noting which courses will address elements of these requirements (note: this is not an exhaustive list):
