

Appeal to the Student Appeals Committee against Research Misconduct

This form is a request to the Student Appeals Committee to review a decision of research misconduct made by a Formal Inquiry Panel, convened by the Dean of Research (or delegate) of the relevant Academic Unit.

This form, together with supporting documentation, must be lodged with the Dean of Graduate Studies, within TWENTY working days of the date specified in the correspondence notifying you of the decision made by the Formal Inquiry Committee.

Grounds for Review

The grounds for appealing a Formal Inquiry Panel outcome are:

- i. the relevant policy and/or procedures were not correctly followed and this resulted in disadvantage to the student; and/or
- ii. new information that supports the student's case for appeal has become available that was not available at the time the decision was made and which should be taken into consideration.
