



## **Aboriginal Scholarships**

Division of Information Technology, Engineering and the Environment

### **INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORM**

#### **Eligibility:**

Must meet the following criteria:

Up to three living allowance scholarships of \$3,000 per year are available to commencing full-time Aboriginal\* students in any of the programs/discipline areas offered by the Division of Information Technology, Engineering and the Environment, listed below, for the duration of the program.

- Bachelor of Aviation (all specialisations)
- Bachelor of Built Environment
- Bachelor of Construction Management and Economics
- Bachelor of Engineering (all specialisations)
- Bachelor of Environmental Science
- Bachelor of Geospatial Science
- Bachelor of Information Technology (all specialisations)
- Bachelor of Mathematics (all specialisations)
- Bachelor of Science
- Bachelor of Software Engineering

#### **Selection Criteria:**

The awarding of a Scholarship is conditional upon meeting the following criteria:

- Selection will be made on the basis of academic merit.
- Recipients must be Aboriginal Australian Citizens
- Scholarship recipients must be enrolled on a full-time basis
- Provision of the scholarship will be subject to satisfactory progress within the program, as defined by University policy
- The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships

The scholarships will not be offered if there are no suitable applicants.

**Value:** \$3,000 per annum for the duration of the program. Payment will be made in two instalments after study period 2 & 5 census dates, subject to satisfactory academic progress.

**Number of scholarships:** Up to three scholarships will be offered each year.

**Duration:** Payable for the duration of the program.

**Review and retention:** Continued provision of the scholarship will be subject to satisfactory progress within the program, as defined by University policy.

**Offers:** The scholarship offer will be made on the basis of program preferences as recorded with SATAC. Offers will be made on a competitive basis to applicants who have lodged a scholarship application with the Division of Information Technology by the closing date 31 March.

#### **Notes:**

The scholarship cannot be deferred if you defer your program of study. You may reapply for a scholarship when you apply to take up your deferred offer.

Acceptance of an Aboriginal Scholarship may put at risk eligibility for receipt of other scholarships (eg Smith Family Learning for Life Scholarship, UniSA Access or Priority Scholarship). It is your responsibility to ensure eligibility requirements are met.

Scholarships may, in some instances, be counted as income against Youth Allowance or other forms of government assistance payments – applicants should seek independent financial advice.
