

ELECTRIC BARBECUE USAGE AGREEMENT

Between; University of South Australia

And The User (USASA affiliated Groups/Clubs/Societies, staff and external hirers)

BACKGROUND:

- The University of South Australia has key operated inbuilt electrical barbecue facilities on each of its metropolitan campuses.
- The barbecue facilities are made available by the University of South Australia for use by USASA affiliated Group/Clubs/Societies, members of staff and external hirers.
- The University of South Australia will issue operating and general safety instructions for the barbecue (Operating Instructions).

AGREEMENT:

The University of South Australia will:

- Ensure that the barbecues are in a reasonable operating condition at the time of use by the User.
- Provide the User with key/s and Operating Instructions.

The User will provide the following:

- Barbecue cleaning equipment.
- Hand washing facilities.
- Fire blanket or have knowledge of fire extinguisher locations.
- Cooking utensils.

The User will:

- Ensure the barbecues are left in a clean, neat and tidy condition after use.
- Utilise the facilities supplied by the University of South Australia on the dates and time as specified on the relevant FM Assist form (FM112 Student Group/Club/Society Function Approval Form or FM153 Staff Function Approval Form).
- Upon collection of the key and Operating Instructions leave a UniSA student ID card as surety if applicable.
- Comply with Operation Instructions.
- Not leave barbecues unattended when turned on.
- Not allow children near the barbecues when in use.
- Ensure plastic utensils are not left in close proximity to hot plates.
- Ensure hot oil is not left to burn on hot plates.
- Return the key/s and Operating Instructions at the conclusion of the function.
- Contact Security immediately in the event of fire.
- Operate the barbecue facilities appropriately in respect with all Occupational, Health, Safety & Welfare Acts and Regulations.
