Include:          Zoom technical requirements video for first time Zoom users          Ask students to prepare any questions they have about Assessment 1          Check Zoom meeting set-up by accessing Zoom meeting via Zoom profile (not via course page). <p><b>Start</b>          1. Start recording:          inform students that the session is now being recorded and where to find the link for the recording (Virtual classroom tab of the course page).          2. Welcome participants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• introduce myself</li> <li>• encourage participants to introduce themselves via Chat</li> <li>• outline the aim / objective for lesson:</li> <li>• to discuss the first assessment and answer questions</li> <li>• encourage students to add questions to the chat</li> <li>• ask students to mute microphone when not speaking to reduce feedback</li> </ul>	5 mins	Recording button  Gallery view  Chat



<p><b>Navigation: Rubric and Feedback</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Share view of course page</li> <li>• Locate Assessments tab</li> <li>• Click on Assessments tab. Scroll to Assignment 1</li> <li>• Click on Course Essentials block and show the Feedback forms/rubric link.</li> <li>• Explain rubric assessment criteria</li> <li>• Answer questions</li> </ul>	5 min	Share screen Course page

<p><b>Q&amp;A</b> Time for students to ask any questions they have about Assessment 1</p>	10 Min	Microphone and/or chat
<p><b>Wrap up and close</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Thank participants for their time and engagement</li> <li>• Recap key points and revisit the outcomes</li> <li>• Stop recording – state where the recording link will be posted on the course page</li> <li>• Export chat</li> </ul>	5 min	Recording button
