AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Current students:

We encourage you to apply regardless of whether you are studying internally, externally, part time, full time or living remotely (country SA, interstate or overseas).

You must be enrolled in an undergraduate or postgraduate Business School program.

Recent graduates:

You must have completed an undergraduate or postgraduate Business School program in the past three years.

HOW DO I APPLY?

- Applications open at the start of Study Period 2
- Submit the online application form, found at: <u>i.unisa.edu.au/students/business/careers/mentor-program</u>
- Complete your online interview—instructions provided in the application process

Interview Tips:

- Be prepared—think about why you are applying and what you want to get out of the BCMP
- Be professional—treat this like a job interview, e.g. dress appropriately
- Be organised—complete your interview by the closing date

WHAT AM I COMMITTING TO?

- The Program from April—October
- An online interview
- A training and preparation session
- Submitting your career goals for the BCMP
- Completing a mentoring agreement
- Attending Connect, the networking event
- A minimum of 6 x 1 hour meetings (face-to-face, online or phone)
- Submitting 5 x 200 word reflections
- Providing feedback upon completion of the BCMP
