About Buffalo, New York

Thirty minutes south of Niagara Falls by car, and nestled on the banks of Lake Erie, Buffalo features mid-century modern architecture, world famous chicken (Buffalo) wings, a thriving food truck culture and a vibrant waterfront district that hosts over 750 concerts annually. Only 90 minutes by plane to the bustling energy of New York City or the historic charm of Boston and 4 hours to the eclectic French-English cultural mix of Montreal in Canada, Buffalo is ideally situated for you to experience the best that North America can offer.

Why should I go on exchange?

By undertaking study overseas you gain a global perspective, increase your knowledge and develop new networks, enriching your life experience.

What can I study?

A variety of semester long courses are available. Discipline areas covered include:

What does it cost?

As an exchange partner with the University of South Australia, you do not have to pay fees at Buffalo State SUNY as these are included as part of your fees at UniSA.

Travel and living expenses are at your own cost. The table below gives an indication of costs you will incur:

ITEM	COST
Return flights - Adelaide to Buffalo	\$2400
Return bus from Buffalo Niagara International Airport to Buffalo State College	\$10 - \$25
Accommodation - on-campus	\$5000 - \$6500 per semester
Health insurance	\$1000 per semester
Meals	\$3250 per semester
Entertainment and incidentals including phone, laundry etc.	\$50 + per week

Key dates

- Fall Semester: August - December which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 5. The closing date for applications is January 11.
- Spring and Summer Semester: January - May which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 2. The closing date for applications is August 1.

How to apply

All exchanges are managed by the study overseas team at UniSA International who will help you apply for your exchange and will contact the partner institution on your behalf.

Entry requirements

Undergraduate:

- A minimum of 36 units undertaken at UniSA with a GPA of 4 or above.

Postgraduate:

- A minimum of 9 units at Masters level at UniSA with a GPA of 4 or above.

Non-English speakers:

- IELTS overall score of 6.0 or above.



Accommodation

Secure on campus accommodation is usually available and is encouraged through the Residence Life office however off campus accommodation is also available and within easy access via public transport. Meal plans are usually purchased by students living on campus.

Credit information

A standard workload is 15 US credits (18 UniSA units). Credit for one UniSA 4.5 subject requires a minimum of 3 US credits. Applicants may undertake a 75% study load on exchange.

Travel information

Students are required to apply for an F1 Visa for study in the United States. Further information will be provided on acceptance in to the program and you are advised to remain informed regarding changes to US immigration laws. For more information on US Visa requirements: au.usembassy.gov/visas/

Travel grant & scholarship information

Minimise your out of pocket travel expenses by applying for one of the University's international travel grants. If you are approved for one of our exchange programs you are eligible to apply. Each eligible student can receive up to \$2500 total in travel grants over their student life at UniSA.

Undergraduate students may apply for Australian Government OS-Help loans to assist with their expenses.

Insurances
