- Postgraduate: Completed an undergraduate degree in a relevant Business Discipline area or at least the equivalent of 180 ECTS credits in Business Studies.
- For non-English speakers, a B2 level (IELTS 6) Certificate in English is required.

Credit information

The KEDGE Business School uses the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System). A standard workload is 30 ECTS per semester. Credit for one UniSA 4.5 unit subject requires a minimum of 7.5 ECTS study. Applicants may undertake a 75% study load on exchange.

Travel information

All students travelling to France require a Visa. Further information will be provided upon acceptance in to the program.

Travel grant & scholarship information

Minimise your out of pocket travel expenses by applying for one of the University's international travel grants. If you are approved for one of our exchange programs you are eligible to apply. Each eligible student can receive up to \$2500 total in travel grants over their student life at UniSA.
