



# STUDENT EXCHANGE LINGNAN (UNIVERSITY) COLLEGE

> CHINA

Lingnan (University) College of Sun Yat-sen University was the first business school in southern China to be recognised with prestigious triple crown accreditation (EQUIS, AACSB, AMBA). The college has a strong global outlook and a focus on social responsibility and leadership. Situated in Guangzhōu, Lingnan (University) College is 3 hours from Hong Kong by train.

## About Guangzhōu, China (PRC)

The third largest city in China, Guangzhōu is a port city situated on the Pearl River and within one of the most economically dynamic regions of the Peoples Republic of China. Famous for its bi-annual Trade Fair, Cantonese food and shopping, Guangzhōu provides visitors with a blend of traditional and modern China on every corner.

## Why should I go on exchange?

By undertaking study overseas you gain a global perspective, increase your knowledge and develop new networks, enriching your life experience.

## What can I study?

There are a variety of semester long courses taught in English available in both the Fall and Spring Semesters. Postgraduate students may study courses from the MBA program. Discipline areas for both undergraduate and MBA include:

- Economics
- Finance
- Human Resource Management
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship
- Management

### SUMMER SCHOOL

The SunYat-sen University (SYSU) International Summer Program is a 3 week program offered in July - August, focusing on Chinese culture, politics, business and economy development in the dynamic Pearl River Delta Region.

The program includes in class lecturers, tours, and local company visits. Students who have completed 18 units of study at UniSA are eligible to apply. Students will need to take two 1.5 credit courses to be equivalent to one 4.5 unit course at UniSA.

## What does it cost?

As an exchange partner with the University of South Australia, you do not have to pay tuition fees to Lingnan (University) College as these are included as part of your fees at UniSA.

Travel and living expenses are at your own cost. The table below gives an indication of costs you will incur:

ITEM	COST
Return flights - Adelaide to Hong Kong	\$950
Return express train from Hong Kong to Guangzhou	\$120 including transfer to train station from the airport
Accommodation	\$850 per month and a 2 month refundable deposit bond
Health insurance	\$80
Meals	\$500 per month
Bus transport to campus	\$30 per month
Entertainment and incidentals including phone, laundry etc.	\$550 - \$600 per month

## Key dates

- Autumn Semester: September - January which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 5. The closing date for applications is January 11.
- Spring Semester: February - June which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 2. The closing date for applications is August 1.
- Summer Semester: 3 weeks July – August corresponding with Study Period 4 at UniSA. The closing date for applications is January 11.

All exchanges are managed by the study overseas team at UniSA International who will help you apply for your exchange and will contact the partner institution on your behalf.

## Entry requirements

- Undergraduate: A minimum of 36 units undertaken at UniSA with a GPA of 4 or above.
- Postgraduate: A minimum of 9 units study in their UniSA masters program with a GPA of 4 or above.

- For non-native English speakers, a TOEFL score of at least 213 (computer-based), 550 (paper-based) or 79 (internet-based), or an IELTS score of at least 6.0 is required.

## Accommodation

Accommodation for international students is available on the main campus of Lingnan (University) College and varies between single and double rooms and shared apartments.

## Credit information

Students must take 11 Lingnan credits for 13.5 UniSA units or 15 Lingnan credits for 18 UniSA units. Applicants may undertake a 75% study load on exchange.

## Travel information

All students travelling to China for study require a student visa. Further information will be provided on acceptance in to the program.

## Travel grant & scholarship information

Minimise your out of pocket travel expenses by applying for one of the University's international travel grants. If you are approved for one of our exchange programs you are eligible to apply. Each eligible student can receive up to \$2500 total in travel grants over their student life at UniSA.

Undergraduate students may apply for Australian Government OS-Help loans to assist with their expenses.

## Insurances

UniSA provides exchange students with Travel Insurance for study related travel. Additionally, all students are required by Ministry of Education, China to purchase the group medical insurance which covers all accidental injury, medical and hospital insurance requirements.
