Located in northwest England, Liverpool is a maritime city on the northwest coast of England. With the most gallieries in the UK outside of London, it was a European Capital of Culture in 2008, and in 2018 is holding a year-long programme of cultural, musical and sporting events to mark the decade and the city's transformation since — and to look to the future. Liverpool is 2 and a half hours by train or a 1 hour 15 minute flight to London and Liverpool airport services local and regional flights to Europe.

What does it cost?

As an exchange partner with the University of South Australia, you do not have to pay fees at the University of Liverpool as these are included as part of your fees at UniSA. Travel and living expenses are at your own cost. The table below gives an indication of costs you will incur:

Return flights - Adelaide to London	\$1800
Return train and bus from London to Liverpool OR	\$50 - \$100
Return flight from London to Liverpool	\$180 - \$220
Accommodation - on-campus, single bedroom, private ensuite	\$1500 per month
Health insurance	\$120 per semester
Meals	\$300 - \$500 per month
Entertainment and incidentals including phone, laundry etc.	\$550 - \$600 per month







Key dates

The following term dates apply to undergraduate courses:

- Semester 1: September January which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 5. The closing date for applications is January 11.
- Semester 2: January June which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 2. The closing date for applications is August 1.

Entry requirements

Undergraduate students should have completed at least 36 units of their Business degree. Postgraduate students should have completed at least 9 units of their Masters degree. For Non-English speakers, supporting documents demonstrating English language proficiency are require.

Accommodation

The University Halls of Accommodation are a safe and fun way to spend your time in Liverpool. You'll live with other international students and there are a variety of room types on campus, some

with en suite facilities and some with a shared bathroom. Students studying in Semester 1 are not guaranteed a place but can apply for a room in the Study Abroad Village. Semester 2 students are guaranteed accommodation and will be given a room in the Study Abroad Village wherever possible. Credit information

The University of Liverpool has a standard workload of 30 units per semester, with each course receiving 7.5 units which is equivalent to one UniSA 4.5 unit subject. Applicants may undertake a 75% study load on exchange.

Travel information

Visas are not required for Australian Citizens if their stay is less than 6 months. All other nationalities should check with their travel agent and provide sufficient time to obtain their visa prior to travel as it can be a lengthy process.

Travel grant & scholarship information

Minimise your out of pocket travel expenses by applying for one of the University's international travel grants. If you are approved for one of our exchange programs you are eligible to apply. Each eligible student can receive up to \$2500 total in travel grants over their student life at UniSA.

Undergraduate students may apply for Australian Government OS-Help loans to assist with their expenses.

Insurances

UniSA provides exchange students with Travel Insurance for study related travel. Additionally, it is mandatory for all students on exchange to have private health insurance with full coverage for sickness, emergencies, repatriation sufficient to cover all medical expenses in the United Kingdom.
