University of Twente is located in the small city of Enschede in the east of the Netherlands. A campus based university, set amongst parks and with on-campus museums. The University of Twente is home to over 10,000 students and has a strong focus on entrepreneurship, innovation and problem solving.

About The Netherlands

The Netherlands, located in north-western Europe, is known for its flat landscape of canals, tulip fields, windmills and cycling routes. It is described as a country of vintage meets contemporary and has a rich cultural history.

Enschede is a few kilometres away from the German border. approximately 2.5 hours by train from Amsterdam. Noted for its outdoor lifestyle, parks and is home to a vibrant student scene.

Why should I go on exchange?

By undertaking study overseas you gain a global perspective, increase your knowledge and develop new networks, enriching your life experience.

What can I study?

There are a variety of semester long courses taught in English available. Discipline areas covered include:

Held in August, this one-of-a-kind course is combination of a summer school and a festival. Offered as a complete package of

course, festival programme, food and accommodation. Courses in 2017 included EntrepreneurialU, Finance Bootcamp for Smart Businesses, Risk Management which upon completion will be awarded 2 ECTS.

What does it cost?

As an exchange partner with the University of South Australia, you do not have to pay tuition fees to the University of Twente as these are included as part of your fees at UniSA.

Travel and living expenses are at your own cost. The table below gives an indication of costs you will incur:

ITEM	COST
Return flights - Adelaide to Amsterdam	\$1400
Return train from Amsterdam to Enschede	\$35
Accommodation	\$640 to \$750 per month
Health insurance	\$120 per semester
Meals	\$320 per month
Entertainment and incidentals including phone, laundry etc.	\$550 - \$600 per month

Key dates

- Spring Semester: February - June which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 2. The closing date for applications is August 1.
- Fall Semester: September - January which corresponds with UniSA Study Period 5. The closing date for applications is January 11.

All exchanges are managed by the study overseas team at UniSA International who will help you apply for your exchange and will contact the partner institution on your behalf.

Entry requirements

- Undergraduate: A minimum of 36 units undertaken at UniSA with a GPA of 4 or above. An internet-based TOEFL score of at least 90 points or equivalent (IELTS 6.5).
- Postgraduate: A minimum of 9 units of study in their Masters program at UniSA with a GPA of 4 or above. An internet-based TOEFL score of at least 90 points or equivalent (IELTS 6.5).

Accommodation

University of Twente guarantees furnished accommodation for all exchange students who complete their application for housing. Accommodation varies between shared apartments and single studios. Should you not wish to utilise your accommodation offer, the housing team will provide you with an overview of options for alternate housing.

Credit information

University of Twente uses the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System). A standard workload is 30 ECTS per semester, with courses either having a value of 15 or 30 ECTS. Credit for one UniSA 4.5 unit subject requires a minimum of 7.5 ECTS study. Applicants may undertake a 75% study load on exchange.

Travel information

Visas are not required for Australian Citizens however they must register for a Resident's Permit within 2 weeks of arrival. All other nationalities should check with their travel agent and provide sufficient time to obtain their visa prior to travel as it can be a lengthy process.

Travel grant & scholarship information

Minimise your out of pocket travel expenses by applying for one of University's international travel grants. If you are approved for one of our exchange programs you are eligible to apply. Each eligible student can receive up to \$2500 total in travel grants over their student life at UniSA.

Undergraduate students may apply for Australian Government OS-Help loans to assist with their expenses.

Insurances

UniSA provides exchange students with Travel Insurance for study related travel. Additionally, it is mandatory for all students on exchange to have private health insurance with full coverage for sickness, emergencies, repatriation sufficient to cover all medical expenses in The Netherlands.
